Spot the Scam: How to Identify a Fraudulent Text Message

Text message scams (also known as *smishing*) are on the rise, and scammers are getting more convincing. At WSSC Federal Credit Union, protecting your personal and financial information is a top priority.



That's why we want to empower you with tips to help you spot a fraudulent message before it does damage.

What Does a Fraud Text Look Like?

Scammers often pretend to be your financial institution, using urgent language to trick you into clicking a link or sharing personal info. These messages may:

- Warn of suspicious activity on your account
- Claim your account is locked or frozen
- Ask you to "verify" information immediately
- Include links that look legitimate but lead to fake sites

Fraud Text Checklist:

Before you respond, ask yourself:

- Does the message ask for sensitive info like your account number or Social Security Number?
- Does it include a suspicious link or unfamiliar phone number?
- Is it creating a sense of urgency or fear to get you to act fast?
- Are there spelling or grammar mistakes?
- Does it come from a generic number (like "5000" or an email address)?

If you answered "yes" to any of these, it's likely a scam.

We'll Never Ask You For...

- Your full account number by text
- Your online banking password
- Your debit card PIN
- Any personal information via a link

If you ever receive a message that seems suspicious, don't click anything. Instead, contact us directly using a trusted method.

If something doesn't feel right, it probably isn't. Call us at 877.977.2328 or visit wsscfcu.org to verify any communication that claims to be from WSSC FCU.

Is Your Credit Card Really Working for You?

When it comes to credit cards, flashy rewards and sign-up bonuses can be tempting. But before you get swept up in the promise of points, miles, or cash back, it's important to take a closer look at the fine print.

- Annual fees Do the perks really outweigh the yearly cost?
- APR (Annual Percentage Rate) A low interest rate saves far more than most rewards can earn.
- Balance transfer and foreign transaction fees Hidden charges that add up fast.
- Reward restrictions Expiration dates, minimum spend requirements, or blackout dates that make rewards difficult to actually use.
